Settling In

Arriving at nursery

Please ensure that your child is brought into nursery, and left with a member of the staff, i.e. children should not be left in the playground, cloakroom, or alone with siblings. Adults leaving children in should also help them to hang up their coat, and get ready to come in.

Paintings and pictures

While your child is in nursery, he/she will be working very hard. Paintings and drawings etc will mean a lot to them. Please remember to take these home (along with any other information which will be placed in the children's drawers). Morning group's drawers are on the left-hand side as you walk through the front door. Afternoon group's are on the right. Please help your child to learn this too. Also, your child will be sharing a coat peg with someone from the other class. Please take care to only take your own belongings home.

Collection

Children will only be released from the nursery into the care of a responsible adult. Please inform the class teacher if there are any changes and ensure that your child knows who is collecting him/her. Please also be prompt when collecting your child. A child who is always last becomes anxious and unsettled.

If you haven't already signed up to **SeeSaw** please contact your child's teacher for registration details. It is a great way to see how your child spends their time at Nursery.

Birthdays

To make your child's birthday a special occasion in nursery, we will provide a small gift and card. As part of our healthy eating policy we ask that parents do not bring cake/party bags into nursery.



Nursery money

£12.00 is requested each month to cover food for snack, ingredients for dough making and other cookery, printing costs, a small birthday and Christmas gift, and other resources. When we have a visitor coming to nursery, we will ask for an additional £3.00 to cover this cost. Nursery money is collected through an internal online payment system. Please do not hand cash to staff.

We will be holding a parent's evening next **Thursday 6th September at 6:30pm** in the school hall. It is a great opportunity for you to learn more about what your child will be doing this year in nursery.
